..redemptive program of God as focused in Jesus Christ... it was a remarkable picture of the high priestly work of Christ, both here on earth and His eternal work in heaven."

INTRODUCTION

- As we study each article in the tabernacle, we will see that Christ who dwelt among us (Jn1:14) has completed the ministry of earthly tabernacle.
- But, there are some timeless principles which are applicable to us. Let us look at them.

DOOR OF THE TABERNACLE

- There was only one door to enter in the presence of God.
- In Gospel of John chapter 10 Jesus said "I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved."
- He is the way, the truth and the life.
 Jn14:6

ALTER OF SACRIFICE

- There is no need of any alter for the sacrifice of animals because Jesus has given the ultimate sacrifice. Jn. 1:23;2:35; Isa. 53 and Heb. 9:27-28
- Timeless principle is that we need to live a sacrificial life as a gratitude to God.

LAVER OR WASH BASIN

- It was used by the priests for ceremonial cleaning.
- The principle is that we need to live a holy life. If we commit sin, we need to ask forgiveness immediately. 1 Jn.1:7-9

TABLE OF SHEWBREAD

 "The twelve loaves of bread constituted a perpetual thank offering to God from the twelve tribes for the blessings that they received from Him day by day." Dr. Constable's notes on Exodus

CONT.

- We should be thankful to God that He provides us spiritual and physical food.
- We should also share this spiritual bread with others.
- Jesus is the bread of life. Jn. 6:35

THE LAMPSTAND

 The lampstand was used to light the holy place but it has a significance that Jesus Christ is the light of the world. In John 8:12 Jesus Said "I am the light of the world." He said these words during the feast of tabernacle.

THE LAMPSTAND

- Jesus also said in Mt.5:14 "You are the light of the world."
- Principle for us is that we need to tell the world that Jesus is the light of the world.
- We also need to shine our light in this dark world. Mt.5:16

TABLE OF INCENSE

- Revelation 8:3 says that prayers of the saints are like incense before God.
- Psalm 141:2 says "May my prayer be set before you like incense; may the lifting up of my hands be like the evening sacrifice."

TABLE OF INCENSE

- It is encouraging for us that our prayers are like an aroma of incense before God.
- His ears are attentive to our cry.
 Psalm 34:15b

ARK OF COVENANT

- The ark of covenant was a constant reminder to them that God is present among them.
- The atonement cover (mercy seat) was a reminder that their sins were atoned by God.

ARK OF COVENANT

- We are taught in the NT that Jesus Christ is our atonement. He did this once for all by His death on the cross. Roman 3:25; 1Jn. 2:2,4:10 and Heb.9:5-7
- We are the vessels who carry the glory of God. 2Cor 4:7

ARK OF COVENANT

 The ark of covenant also signifies that God is faithful. He who keeps all His promises, therefore we should also be faithful in everything.

APPLICATION

- 1. We need not bring sacrifice for salvation but bring your sacrifices for service.
- 2. We should live a sanctified life for the glory of God.
- 3. We should be thankful to God for meeting all our daily needs.

APPLICATION

- 4. We should witness that Jesus is the light of the world and shines our light in this dark world.
- 5. We should bring our prayers before God. He loves when we pray.

APPLICATION

- 6. We should be faithful to God and His people.
- 7. We should enjoy the presence of God in our life. He is with us and in us all the time. John 14:17
