**HOW TO GROW IN INTIMATE

Dedicate your Bodies :

- Rom.12:1 says that, offer your bodies as living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God-this is your spiritual act of worship.
- Eph.4:17-24 states that before becoming believer we used our bodies for sinful acts and purposes but now since we are saved our bodies have become the temple of living God (ICor.6:19-20), Spirit of God dwells in us(Rom.8:9), so we need to use our bodies to glorify God (I Cor. 9:27, Phil. 1:20-21).
- Romans 6:13 teaches us to use parts of our bodies as instruments for righteous living. Dedicate parts of your bodies only to be used as God's instruments.

Dedicate your Minds:

- World want to control our mind but God want to transform our minds (Col. 3:1-14). World try to change us from outside in but God changes us from inside out for progressive transformation (II Cor. 3:18).
- Transforming is like transfiguration (Metamorphosis e.g. caterpillar changing in to butterfly) -Mt. 17:2, Eph. 4:23, Philp. 2:5-11 commands us to have mind of Christ.
- God's Word and God the Holy Spirit can transform our minds to his likeness. Rom. 12:2 teaches us our minds need to be transformed instead of conforming to the pattern of this world. Are you conformer or transformer? Dedicate to be transformed.

Dedicate your Will:

- Your “Will” control your mind and your mind control your body. Many people think that they control their by their “Will Power” but they fail ultimately as scriptures explains in Rom.7:15-21.
- We need to yield our will to God and allow the Holy Spirit to guide our thinking and actions. Like Daniel, conscious and deliberate decision have to be made. Pray like Jesus, “not My will but Your will be done.”
- Start the day with surrendering your body, transform your mind reading the word and yielding your will to His will on daily basis.

Conclusion:

- Dedicate your bodies as living sacrifice and stay on the alter.
- Renew your mind by studying God's word daily.
- Spend time in prayer to yield your will to His Will.
